HERE TO HELP

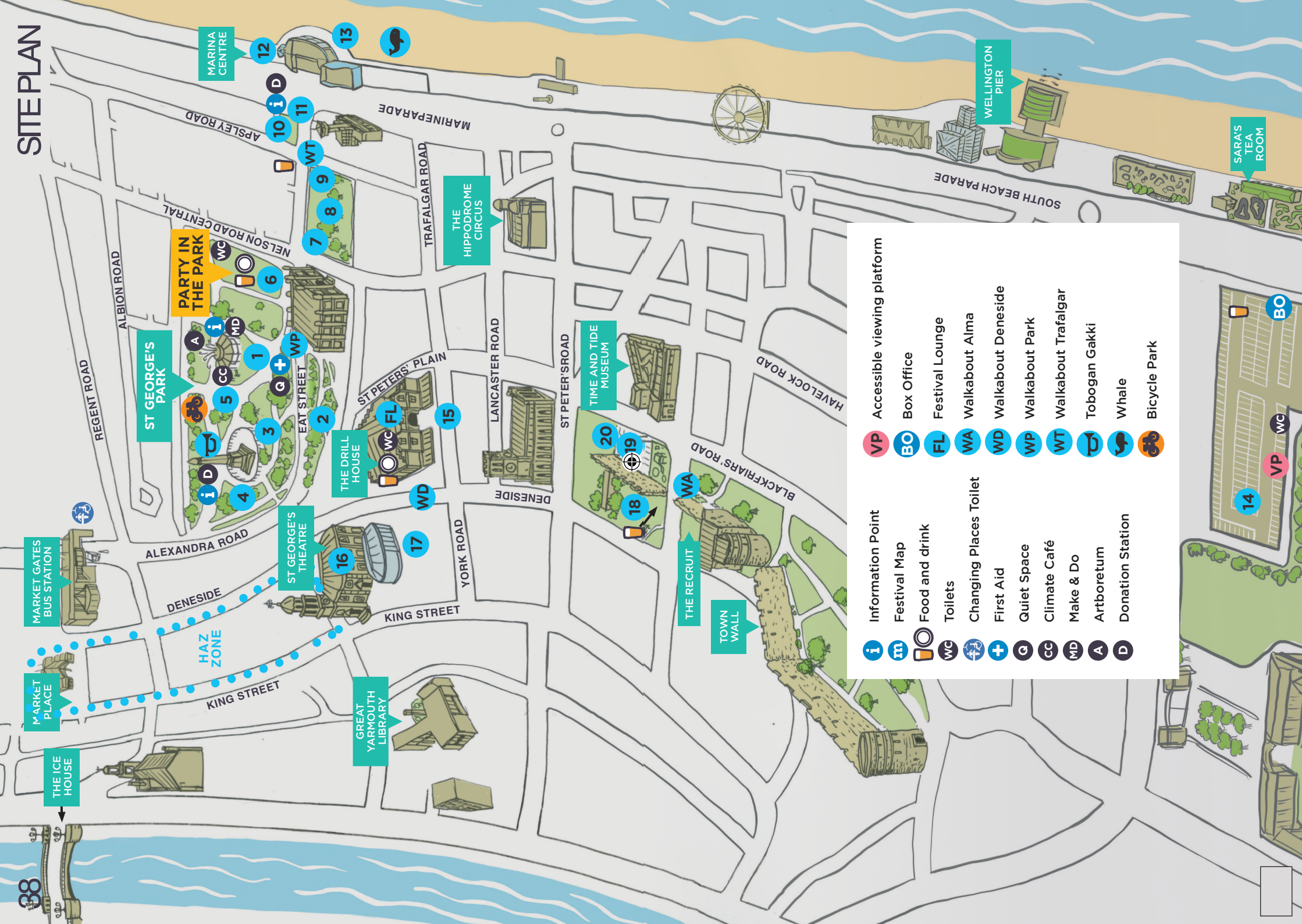
You'll spot our Festival Hosts around the park and at the Info Points. They'll help with enquiries, point you in the right direction and give you some festival tips.
