Smartphone Photography and Videography Workshop

Join us for a special edition of Stomping Ground!, where we will be kickstarting two very exciting projects: Beach of Dreams and Winter Gardens - Illuminate.

Help us document Great Yarmouth's rich social and environmental history, by getting involved in an exciting Smartphone Photography and Videography Workshop. Take creative control of your smartphone, learn the basic rules of composition, the importance of light, practicalities of outdoor photography, reviewing and editing your top photos.

Participants will join Dr. Deborah Jeffries, a Historian specialising in Victorian entertainment arts and architecture, as well as our Beach of Dreams and Winter Gardens Artists on a whistle-stop Heritage Entertainment tour of some of Great Yarmouth's iconic landmarks including, the Hippodrome, the Windmill and the Winter Gardens.

The content captured will feed into both projects - dazzling visual animations for projections on the Winter Gardens and striking visual designs for Kinetika's silk pennants and banners, which will be displayed en masse at Out There Festival 2025.

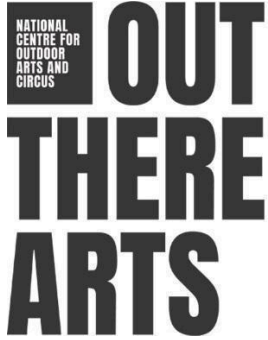

About Stomping Ground!

Stomping Ground! is a brand-new Youth Club in Great Yarmouth for children and young people aged 11-18 (up to 25 for SEND). It is produced by Out There Arts, with activity co-curated by the Young Out There Collective. The Youth Club takes place fortnightly on Wednesdays at Charter Academy (Salisbury Rd, Great Yarmouth, NR30 4LS), from 5pm - 7pm, and on Saturdays at The Drill House (York Road, Great Yarmouth, NR30 2LZ) from 1pm - 5pm.

The sessions are free for all, drop-in, accessible, inclusive, and youth-led, with the aim to provide a safe space for children and young people to socialise, learn new skills, collaborate with artists and each other. The project is funded by The National Lottery Community Fund.

About Winter Gardens

The Winter Gardens is a Grade II* listed building 'at risk' and currently without a sustainable, viable use. It is the last surviving example of a Victorian ironwork glasshouse in the UK that sits on a seaside promenade. Since its closure in 2008, Great Yarmouth Borough Council has worked to identify a future sustainable use for the building. In 2021, the Winter Gardens was one of five transformational heritage projects across the country to be awarded a Heritage Horizon Award from the National Lottery Heritage Fund. The project team is now working on the full restoration and repurposing of the building, with building works commencing in March 2025, with completion in Summer 2027.

About Beach of Dreams

Beach of Dreams aims to engage hundreds of thousands across the UK in a major interdisciplinary programme including commissioned artworks responding to coastal, environmental and climate themes; walks; journeys; participatory creative events; digital activity; talks and other events along the UK coastline in the 4 nations of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.

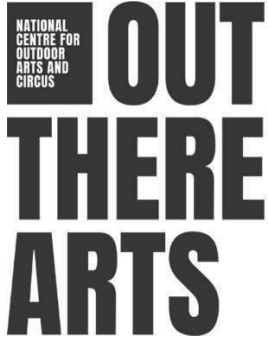
