We are deploying a variety of initiatives in place to remove barriers to attendance and greater engagement. SITE ACCESSIBILITY

- Each site/pitch will be wheelchair accessible. Where appropriate ramps will be provided to ensure level access. There will be trackway on the beach to ensure access.
- Out There Festival welcomes assistance dogs. Drinking bowls are available from the bar tent in St George's Park.
- There will be a range of seating provided including benches and chairs and additional seating available to borrow. Each pitch will have priority seating for those who need it.
- There will be several marquees offering covered space around the festival site.
 You are also welcome to take shelter in the Festival Lounge.
- There will be a Mobile Changing Places toilet in the park on Friday and Saturday, open 12pm-8pm.

AUDIO DESCRIPTION

Select shows will have Audio Description which narrates the visual elements of a show for visually impaired members of the audience.

You can pick up the audio description kit from the Access Hub. Alternatively, at Audio Described shows volunteers will be handing the kits out. They will also tell you which Channel to set your kit to, either 1 or 2. Once you have got your kit, you can keep hold of it for the day and hand it back at the Access Hub or to the Audio Describers at the end of the day.

If you would like to listen to the Audio Description and you have hearing aids, neck loops are available too.

Some shows will have Audio Intros. These will be available on our website as well as accessible using a QR code at the show's pitch.

Justice in Motion - CODE has prerecorded Audio Description. The team will hand out headsets at the Pitch.

TOUCH TOURS

Touch Tours are for you to familiarise yourself with the festival area, props and sounds used in the experience. It is also an opportunity to meet the cast and ask any questions you may have that would help when watching the show later on.

Touch Tours are designed for visually impaired people and people with Special Educational Needs, however, if you think you would benefit from attending please feel free.

Families with an access user in the group are all welcome to join the tour.

QUIET SPACES

Quiet spaces will be available throughout the weekend where you can escape the hubbub of the festival. There will be sensory aids and ear defenders provided. There will be one in the park and one on the beach - they are marked on the map. You can ask staff, volunteers or access stewards to show you where they are.



This symbol will be displayed on the map to indicate where the Quiet Spaces are.

BRITISH SIGN LANGUAGE

Selected performances of shows with heavy dialogue will be British Sign Language Interpreted. The place the interpreter will stand during the performance will be marked as 'BSL Zone'.

Some installations will also have BSL videos which can be accessed using a QR code.



This symbol will be displayed to indicate shows that will be BSL interpreted.



RELAXED PERFORMANCES

Some shows will be a relaxed performance. A relaxed performance is designed to have a less formal, more supportive, atmosphere in order to reduce anxiety levels. Performances will be adapted in a variety of ways, including a more relaxed attitude to noise, in order to ensure a safe, enjoyable festival visit.

Relaxed performances will include a 5 minute relaxed opening and a 5 minute Q&A with the artists at the end.

They are programmed during the quieter hours of the festival. However, as it is an outdoor arts festival we cannot limit or predict audience numbers.

ACCESS HUB

The Access Hub will be your port of call for any access needs. There will be members of staff and volunteers in pink t-shirts here to answer any questions. There will be resources here such as the Easy Read Guide, Sensory Guide and Visual Guide.

You can pick up any equipment you may need such as ear defenders or headphones for audio description.

Our Access Buddies are there to ensure you are comfortable at the festival. This might include escorting you to a particular show or just having a chat. The Access Hub is in the park, marked on the map.
