# Welcome to the 2025 Out There Festival!

This is the 17th edition of the festival and it's truly an extra special one. Many special projects and partnerships are contributing to this being one of the biggest and most anticipated festivals we have ever produced. A huge programme is spread out over four days, with over 60 artistic companies and 250 artists, 17 International companies, 18 World or UK premieres, over 150 performances and 9 special shows and experiences having been 'Made in Great Yarmouth' through our residency and outreach programmes.

This year Out There hosts the Circostrada 'Fresh Street' International gathering of several hundred professionals from all over the world working in Outdoor Arts coming together to share ideas and engage with the festival. This is the first time in the UK and it's helping us also launch three years of partnership work with other festivals around the world to exchange artists and grow Out There's established role as a key international gateway. We have a fabulous international programme this year including artists from Spain (including a special Catalan focus), Portugal, France, Italy, Germany, Belgium, Latvia, Lithuania, South Africa, Switzerland, Australia, Ireland, New Zealand and more

Many of the companies participating have also been here throughout the year creating and engaging over 4000 young people, many of whom are shaping the growing 'Young Out There' strand. Out There is a founding partner in the 'Freshly Greated' consortium and together we have produced all kinds of participatory opportunities across the festival this year with fantastic things to both see and do for everyone. This includes the 'Beach of Dreams' - Kinetika's national celebration of coastal heritage manifesting itself here on our beach with a mass of community created pennants, climbable bamboo structures, shows, talks and more.

And finally we launch our new Ice House venue after many years of planning, fundraising and building. 'Siku' will be the first show to be presented there - keeping it icy with a circus show set in the arctic of yesteryear.




We urge you all to make the most of this very special year and get Out There!
